TechNode-AOE Aperio Offline Encoder



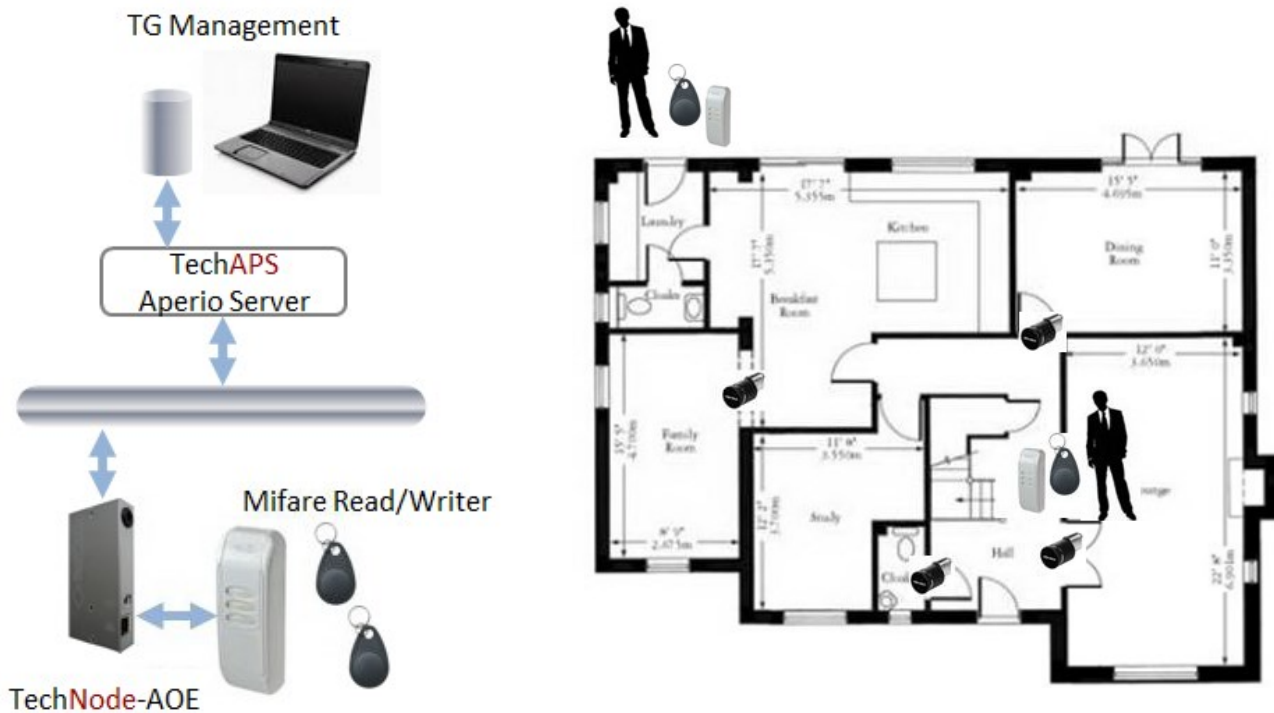
TechNode-AOE:

 - Mifare Classic.
 - Mifare DESFire.

Aperio offline means:

- All access rights are stored on RFID credentials.
- No installation of other hardware.



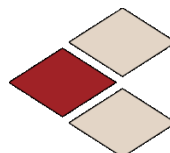


TechNode-AOE (Aperio Offline Encoder) receiving card-holder access rights from the PC application TechAPS (Aperio Server) and communicate access rights formatted data to an external Mifare Read/Writer (Deister PRM5f/2) for encoding Mifare tags/cards and in according to the Aperio offline specifications.

TechAPS is able to be customized to different kind of Access Management systems to achieve card-holder Access rights. TechAPS supports:

- ThorGuard Management (TGM) database

The Card-holder must periodically present the card to a dedicated card Read/Writer for updating the access rights.
